

Jesus is so above everyone else it has to be stated multiple times. I also do not feel that three times is ironic. The fact that we have the Holy Trinity could be part of the reason for three, but I certainly do not believe that it is the full reason for that. So next time you read through your Bible, look for repetition and try to figure out why it is important enough to be repeated!

GOD WANTS TO BLESS YOU ... It is one of many recurring themes throughout the Bible. Blessings come in many different ways to a diverse set of people, even animals. On day 5 of the creation, "God blessed them [the animals] and said, 'Be fruitful and increase in number..." (Gen. 1:22) On day 6 He blessed humanity: "God blessed them and said to them, 'Be fruitful and increase in number: fill the earth and subdue it" (Gen. 1:28) The blessing continued with Abram. "The Lord had said to Abram, 'Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show vou.' I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you." (Gen. 12:1-3) That blessing is repeated several times, not only to Abraham but to Isaac and Jacob. Sometimes blessings came in unconventional ways. Jacob, the con artist and his mother, Rebekah, tricked Isaac in to bestowing Esau's blessing on Jacob. (Gen. 27). Many blessings came unexpectedly. After stealing Esau's blessing, Jacob receives the blessing of his father, Isaac, as he sent him on his way to escape the wrath of Esau. (Gen. 28) And Jacob is REALLY surprised when, at Bethel, he unexpectedly receives a visit from God who announces that his offspring will be like the dust of the earth. (Gen. 28:10-16) In the ensuing years Jacob's wealth is expanded. He obtains 4 wives, 11 children. He finally gets a new name. No longer is he known as "heelgrabber" or "supplanter" but as "one who contends with God." Finally Jacob is surprised by the blessing he receives when he is reunited with Esau. Throughout the Bible God expresses a desire to bless. And He wants to bless you! He also wants to be a blessing THROUGH you!
