

CELEBRATING LOVE...to say that Billy Graham commanded respect is the ultimate understatement. His message—the gospel was born out by his character. Young and old, affluent and poor, conservative and liberal were in nearly total agreement in the way Dr. Graham lived. When he spoke we heard the unadulterated presentation of the gospel in public places on a national scale that was unsurpassed in recent decades. Very few complained, and those that did were pretty much ignored! The message was proclaimed in a most gracious way, always highlighting the fact that "God loves you." Billy Graham died on February 21, 2018. That he died in February, the month we think about love, is a poignant reminder of his lifelong message.

Billy Graham's message was one of grace—God's grace. Max Lucado writes, "(God) starts the process. He doesn't just love, he lavishes us with love (1 John 3:1 NIV). He doesn't dole out wisdom; he 'gives generously to all without finding fault' (James 1:5). He is rich in 'kindness, tolerance and patience' (Rom. 2:4). His grace is 'exceedingly abundant' (1 Tim. 1:14) and 'indescribable' (2 Cor. 9:14-15).

The world desperately needs to hear this message of grace. South Knoxville desperately needs to hear it. Should we not be the messengers of such good news? All around us are people who long to hear it. They just don't know it. Pray that God will place you in the path of people who need to hear about Jesus. When your find yourself there—and you will—open your mouth with the expression, "God loves you!"

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Meridian Family,

Here is a heartwarming story I recently read.

A 3 year old girl by the name of Katie was taken to her pediatrician during a recent bout with the flu. As the doctor examined her ears, he asked, "Will I find Big Bird in here?" Apprehensively, Katie replied, "No." Then, before examining her throat, he asked, "Will I find the Cookie Monster in here?" Again, "No." Finally, listening to her heart, he asked, "Will I find Barney in here?" With innocent conviction, she looked him directly in the eye and said, "No, Jesus is in my heart. Barney is on my underwear."

Katie's innocence teaches us all a great lesson, and serves as a reminder that everyone should take spiritual inventory by asking themselves the following question; "Has there ever been a time in your life when you asked the Lord Jesus Christ into your heart by trusting in Him as your personal Lord and Savior?" You see, there is a drastic difference between having head knowledge about Jesus Christ, and having genuine sincere heart knowledge. Head knowledge will not get you to heaven. The Bible tells us that even the demons believed that Jesus was the Son of God (James 2:19). Mere intellectual knowledge of who Jesus was along with a familiarity of His teachings will not provide salvation for the lost soul. Rather, the only way a person can be genuinely saved and receive the precious gift of eternal life, is to receive Christ as personal Savior and Lord. We rest in what the Apostle Paul wrote to the church in Rome when he said. "if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved (Romans 10:9)."
